Prof Keene is a clinical academic physiotherapist specialising in the development and evaluation of complex interventions to improve the management of musculoskeletal injuries. He is the Kadoorie Professor of Trauma Rehabilitation at the University of Oxford. He is also a Senior Research Fellow at Lincoln College and a Clinical Specialist Physiotherapist at the Royal United Hospitals Bath NHS Foundation Trust. He has held a National Institute for Health and Care Research (NIHR) Postdoctoral Fellowship and a Developing Skills Enhancement Award. He is currently Chief or co-Investigator on several NIHR-funded multicentre clinical trials. His research has been published in high-impact general medical journals (Lancet, JAMA and BMJ) and in leading speciality journals. He is also a member of the NIHR Health Technology Assessment General Funding Committee.
